THEMES AND PROMISES

Week#1 (18th Sunday in Ordinary Time)

[Dispossession]

Theme: New life in Christ is putting to death earthly desire.

Promise: *“When Christ your life appears, then you too will appear with him in glory.”* (Col 3:4)

Week#2 (19th Sunday in Ordinary Time)

[Stewardship]

Theme: New life in Christ is faithfulness to do His work.

Promise: *“Do not be afraid any longer, little flock, for your Father is pleased to give you the kingdom.”* (Lk 12:32)

Week #3 (20th Sunday in Ordinary Time)

[Service]

Theme: New life in Christ is being one with Mary in her holiness and service.

Promise: *“Blessed are you who believed that what was spoken to you by the Lord would be fulfilled.”*
(Lk 1:45)

Week #4 (21st Sunday in Ordinary Time)

[Submission]

Theme: New life in Christ is accepting God’s discipline.

Promise: *“All discipline...brings the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who are trained by it.”* (Heb 12:11)

Week #5 (22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time)

[Humility]

Theme: New life in Christ is conducting our affairs with humility.

Promise: *“For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted”* (Lk 14:11)
